



1. Outer Configuration




- 1:T-Pad

2. Headband




Headband can be adjusted max. at 40mm(monaural) or 80mm(binaural) to meet different people's requirements for comfort wearing.




Swing boom is 330° rotatable.

Position the microphone boom to leave a width of 30-50mm between the lower lip and microphone for best communicating position.

Notes:Don't rotate the boom over 330°!



Speaker assembly jointed max. at 180° to adjust the ear cushion for comfort wearing.
